

WACUA Life Membership Criteria and Application



Life Membership is the highest honour that can be received by a member of our Association. Our Life Members are highly regarded for supporting the values of the Association and contributing to the Association in a capacity that is considered above and beyond over an extended period of service.

To be considered for Life Membership the nominee **MUST** satisfy the following criteria:

- Membership of the WACUA for a minimum of 10 years.
- OR**
- Served the WACUA off field with distinction over an extended period of time.
(This must be described in detail by both the nominee and seconder.)
 - Has consistently represented the WACUA in an exemplary manner to internal and external stakeholders.

In addition, they must have demonstrated, to a high standard, at least **TWO** of the criteria below:

- Service as a member of the Committee.
- Support of fellowship among and/or development of peers.
 - *Eg formally mentoring fellow members, being actively involved in developing members (training sessions / workshops).*
- Service to umpiring cricket at National and / or International level while a member of the Association.
- Promotion of the WACUA and/or umpiring.
- Service and promotion of cricket.
- Other (nominee and seconder to detail)

Life Membership – Nomination Process

The WACUA Life Membership nomination must be in writing (electronic form, email, letter).

The process is as follows:

- Nominations must be submitted (**30 days**) prior to the Annual General Meeting, as per our constitution, to be accepted.
- Nominate only one member per application. If you want to nominate more than one member, please complete the application multiple times.
- Your nomination must be seconded by another member as per our constitution.
- Please make sure you have coordinated with the seconder to approve your nomination beforehand.
Non-seconded nominations cannot be accepted.
