WACUA Life Membership Committee Structure

Annually, all members are invited to offer nominations of candidates they feel worthy of Life Membership to the Life Membership Committee.



The Life Membership Committee is a sub-committee to the WACUA Committee and comprises of the following:

• Structure

- \circ $\,$ One representative from the current WACUA Committee who will be the chair.
- Two Life Member representatives.
- Two Ordinary Member representatives.

(Diversity on the committee should be encouraged.)

- Nominations for membership for the committee will be called for from the floor at the AGM for Ordinary Members. If more nominations than positions are received, a vote will be put to the membership at the AGM.
- Life Members will be asked to nominate in writing.
- The WACUA Committee will select its member at the first committee meeting after the AGM.

Life Membership Committee Role

- The Life Membership Committee reviews all nominations to moderate and minimise the subjective understanding of the criteria and determine those suitable to be endorsed and returned to the WACUA Committee who will present it to the membership at the following AGM for final approval.
- If a Life Membership Committee member is nominated for Life Membership, they will excuse themselves from the committee and be replaced by a member of the appropriate group.

Note:

• If the WACUA Committee has queries with the Life Membership Committee 's recommendations – they go back to the Life Membership Committee with their questions. The Life Membership Committee makes the final recommendation.

Life Membership – Final Approval

• Final approval is done by secret ballot at the following AGM, a vote three quarters (75%) of the majority is required to approve the nomination.
